

Choosing Committee Members

Each student is required to have a Master's Report/Thesis Committee comprised of at least two individuals, typically a supervisor and a reader. Only GSC members may be designated as a supervisor, while any faculty member or even a member of your organization who meets the criteria set forth by the program, may serve as a reader. However, the case may arise where the instructor that you prefer to supervise your report/thesis is not a GSC member. In that event, you will designate two co-supervisors – the supervisor you prefer plus an additional instructor who is a member of the GSC.
